Methodology - waste management

- Check of the legal compliance with the waste management act corrections
- Depending on the company structure: Showing the waste streams according to type of waste, waste quantities and costs
- Check of the weakpoints of the waste logistics
- Determination of minimisation and cost reduction potentials
- Definition, implementation and controlling of measures

Setting up the in-company waste logistics



- Involvement of the employees in their respective working areas
- Information on the correct waste separation
- Adapted container systems

- Re-design of the waste collection points
- Involve the cleaning personnel
- Motivation of all involved persons
