

## Rules for team-work

- Avoid to be soft, just to achieve unanimity or to avoid conflicts. Just support other opinions, when they correspond with yours at least in some parts
- Avoid conflict solution technologies, e.g. majority voting, average calculations or cow trade (one hand washes the other)
- View deviate opinions as a useful contribution instead of feeling to be disturbed
